

BA (HONS) ACTING (COLLABORATIVE AND DEVISED THEATRE) ADDITIONAL COSTS

Students should be aware that there may be other costs in addition to their tuition fees. Some of the potential costs you may need to consider are provided in the table below, but please note that this is not an exhaustive list.

Item	Cost
Accommodation and living costs (The School does not provide its own accommodation but can offer advice and support about finding somewhere to live: https://www.cssd.ac.uk/content/accomm-odation-support).	<p>Costs vary, but students can expect to pay between £150-£210 per week in rent (depending on location, accommodation/room type, and, in the case of halls of residence, whether they are catered).</p> <p>Students should additionally budget for a further £150-£190 in living costs per week (including utilities and phone/broadband bills, food, entertainment, and insurance). Travel to and from Central	<p>Costs vary depending on the form of transport and the distance travelled, though we recommend that students budget for approximately £30 per week.</p>
Travel to and from offsite placements/ projects/ teaching sites and rehearsal/ performance venues	<p>There may be periods in the academic year when teaching or project/placement activity takes place offsite.</p> <p>Costs vary depending on the form of transport and the distance travelled.</p>
Clothing Students are expected to own the following, as appropriate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 2 x fitted black t-shirt or black leotard; • Black tracksuit bottoms or leggings; • Fitted black hoodless sweater or sweatshirt; • Simple black trainers or plimsolls / character shoes (for term 2) /black dress shoes (for term 2) • Several pairs of black socks; 	<p>Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier.</p>

Props/costumes As briefed during the course; to include two good quality tennis balls	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier.
Yoga mat	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier, but students can expect to pay between £70-£80.
Stationery At least A5 size, pencils, pencil sharpeners, pens, erasers, highlighters	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier.
Play texts As briefed	Costs vary.
Theatre/film visits	Costs will vary, but you can expect to spend between £75-£200 per term.
Professional headshots (Third year; including costs associated with marketing yourself and corresponding with agents).	Between £150-£400.
Computer / Laptop / Storage Devices / Software / Broadband (The School's computer rooms contain desktop computers, specialist software and printers for you to use, however you may wish to purchase your own computer / printer / storage devices / software).	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier. Recommended personal computer and home broadband specifications can be found here: https://www.cssd.ac.uk/fees-funding/tuition-fees-and-additional-costs
Printing / Photocopying (Students are given £1 at the beginning of their studies, but are otherwise expected to pay their own costs).	Current printing costs at Central: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A4 Black and White – 4p/sheet • A4 Colour – 15p/sheet • A3 Colour – 30p/sheet • Plotter Printing – 30p/sheet
Graduation costs	Approximately £55.00 for robe hire.
