#### **PROFILE**

I'm an acting teacher and theatre director, specialising in new writing, commissioning and developing plays within the conservatoire and for industry. I'm training to become a humanistic psychotherapist at the Metanoia Institute. I've been on faculty at Central since 2005, as Course Leader of MA Classical Acting before developing the Contemporary course and becoming Programme Leader of MA Acting from 2010-2021. I currently teach Stanislavsky derived acting techniques, approaches to new writing, scene study, and direct public productions.

After reading for a BA in Drama and English at Bristol University and an MPhil at Brunel University, I completed a PG Cert LTHE at Central. I'm a fellow of the HEA. I trained as a theatre director at The Orange Tree (with Sam Walters), at the Donmar Warehouse/ Carlton TV (with Sam Mendes) and at the National Theatre Studio.

Subsequently I worked as a freelance theatre director for The Orange Tree, The Gate, National Theatre Studio, Show of Strength at The Tobacco Factory, Brighton Festival and New Perspectives; as Associate Director of Live Theatre, Newcastle; and as Artistic Director of Lincoln Community Play and Forest Forge Theatre Company.

I have taught, led masterclasses or directed projects for RADA, LAMDA, Rose Bruford College, Moscow Arts Theatre School, The Classical Studio at TISCH, Juilliard, NIDA, Ryerson University, Universidad Central del Colombia, Northumbria University, Bristol University, Steppenwolf, Royal Court, RSC, Shakespeare's Globe, Hampstead Theatre and the National Theatre Studio amongst others.

At Central, I manage a commissioning programme that enables leading and emerging female playwrights to write large cast plays. I also led on an Arts Council England funded new writing partnership project with WGGB and Leicester Square Theatre.
