

## SET & COSTUME DESIGNER: SAMMY DOWSON

Sammy trained at the Slade School of Fine Art. Resident at the Orange Tree Theatre in Richmond from 2000 - 2016, she designed over 70 in-the-round productions. Since 2014 Sammy has designed multiple works for Oldham Coliseum, Chipping Norton, Dukes Lancaster; and in London, The Other Palace, Arcola, Latchmere 503 and Arts and Gardens. Credits for Central, *Heresy Of Love*, *Beweep Outcast*, *Burial At Thebes*, *Bones*, *Light Shining In Buckinghamshire*, *The Herd*, *The Censor* and *Galapagos*. She is an associate of BOLD Theatre.

## MUSIC & SOUND DESIGNERS: JOSEPH EVANS & TOM SHARKETT

Tom Sharkett and Joseph Evans are the song-writing partnership behind W.H. Lung. Since 2019, they have released two albums via Melodic Records. They have been highlighted by The Guardian as 'ones to watch', with The Times labelling them as 'the sort of band who inspire fervent devotion.' They have toured extensively throughout the UK, Europe and the US. This year, Tom released his debut solo EP via Optimo Music. Joseph is a recent graduate of MA Acting Contemporary at Central.

## MOVEMENT DIRECTOR: AMIT LEVY

Amit is an international director, movement director, and physical theatre educator. She trained as a theatre director at Seminar Hakibutzim (BA) in Tel Aviv and has an MA in Creative Practice from Trinity Laban Conservatoire. Since then, Amit has worked and trained with

Frantic Assembly, Kneehigh and Gecko. She has been a movement director for over 25 shows, both in the UK and in Israel. Amit directed at the Israeli National Theatre (Habima), Habait Theatre, Tzavta Theatre, The Cameri Theatre and regularly teaches and directs in leading drama schools in the country.

## LIGHTING DESIGNER: HUGO DODSWORTH

Hugo is a performance designer, working holistically across disciplines of set, costume, lighting, and video design. He trained at Bristol Old Vic Theatre School, graduating in 2022 with an MA in Performance Design. Prior to his design training, Hugo received his BA (Hons) in Italian and History of Art from UCL in 2021, for which he spent a year working as an electrician and lighting design assistant at Teatro alla Scala in Milan in 2019. Credits include *Catastrophe Bay* (Bristol Old Vic), *Loam* (Bristol Old Vic), *Girl In The Machine* (Wardrobe Theatre), *The Last Days Of Judas Iscariot* (The Station), *Romeo And Juliet* (Redgrave Theatre), *Little Light* (Tower Theatre), *Illusion* (Bloomsbury Theatre), and *Not The End Of The World* (Cockpit Theatre).

## FIGHT DIRECTOR: BETHAN CLARK

Bethan Clark is a fight director, action coordinator and Certified Teacher with the British Academy of Dramatic Combat. Fight direction credits include *The Prince* (Southwark Playhouse), *As You Like It* (Northern Broadsides), *The Bolds* (The Unicorn), *Our Lady Of Blundellsands* (Liverpool Everyman), *The Last Ship* (Northern Stage and US Tour), *Marvin's Binoculars* (The Unicorn), *The Effect* (English Theatre Frankfurt), *Macbeth* (Queens Theatre Hornchurch and Derby

Playhouse), *A View From The Bridge* (York Theatre Royal), *Our Lady Of Kibeho* (Royal and Derngate, Theatre Royal Stratford East), *My Beautiful Laundrette* (Leicester Curve), and *Lord Of The Flies* (Theatr Clwyd & Sherman Theatre).

## COSTUME SUPERVISOR: PIPPA BATT

Pippa trained in theatre design at Cleveland College of Art and Design before undertaking the Postgraduate Diploma in Theatre Costume at RADA, where she has since worked as Assistant Head of Wardrobe since 2014. Recent credits as Costume Supervisor include *Heathers The Musical* (original UK production, West End and UK tours), *Saturday Night Fever* (UK and international tours), *The Exorcist* (UK tour), *Ten Times Table* (UK tour), *Hamlet* (Kenneth Branagh Productions), *The Great Christmas Feast* (The Lost Estate), *But I'm A Cheerleader* (Turbine Theatre), and *The Pleasure Garden* (Above the Stag Theatre). As Costume Designer *Insomnia* gaming festivals (Dubai and Saudi Arabia).

## STAGE MANAGER: PREECE KILICK

Preece studied acting at the Bristol Old Vic Theatre School before turning to directing and stage management in 2007. Work has included many collaborations

with the Park Theatre including *Whodunnit 2 - Murder At Sea* and *Tony! The Tony Blair Rock Opera*. Also, *The Simon and Garfunkel Story* (West End & International Tour), *The Great Gatsby Immersive* (London), five years in opera including Opera Brava and ENO, and work with Italia Conti and Mountview. Preece is also a writer and trained dancer.

## DEPUTY STAGE MANAGER: MEGAN MORRIS

Megan has recently graduated with a Master's in Stage and Production Management from Guildford School of Acting. Alongside her training, Megan's professional credits include Company Stage Manager (on book) on two pantomime productions at Millfield Theatre, Stage Manager (on book) for London Studio Centre's Seedtime Production, and Technical Stage Manager for Greenside Venues at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival 2022.
