Biography

Joseph is a movement director, facilitator and teacher. He has worked nationally and internationally as a theatre director and teacher, devising and collaborating on productions and projects with some of the world's most acclaimed companies and institutions.

Joseph graduated with a 1st class degree in Physical Theatre from East 15 Acting School and has since trained extensively in Biomechanics, ensemble devising and contemporary movement practices.

As a facilitator and associate he has worked with Barbican, Brixton Project, Complicité, David Glass Ensemble, HOME, National Children's Orchestra, National Youth Orchestra Tamasha, Redbridge Drama Centre and more.

He has taught at ALRA, Central Saint Martins, East 15 Acting School, Liverpool School of Theatre, and Manchester Metropolitan University.

Alongside work as a movement director and teacher, Joseph is Artistic Director of award-winning Babel Theatre where he oversees the creative direction and implementation of arts programs and projects across the country. Through their productions, he investigates appropriate forms to unpack the contemporary experience of living.

Joseph is passionate about 21st century actor training, contemporary devising practices, ensemble theatre making, and making creative experiences inclusive and accessible. He has recently worked alongside Lambeth Council and The Brixton Project and deliver *Rooted*, a new creative arts program exploring the post-colonial body, and with Make it in Brixton and the Mayor's Creative Enterprise Zone supported projects with *White Allies* which invites white people to investigate how they have profited from racism and oppression.
