Sita is a Creative Associate at Watford Palace Theatre, Associate Director at Kali Theatre, and has worked as a trainee Artistic Director at the Bush Theatre. She holds a PhD examining issues of cultural diversity in Shakespearean performance (University of Warwick) and a Masters in Movement Direction (Royal Central School of Speech and Drama).

Sita is also presenter of Channel 5's flagship children's television programme milkshake!
