If you pay income tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return, or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

For VAT purposes, your contribution is split as follows: Stalls donation £1,105, benefits £95; and Circle donation £205, benefits £95. As with all donations, your generous gift will not warrant your involvement in decisions regarding Central's management or operation. We will never sell your data onto third parties.

THE DIRECT DEBIT GUARANTEE

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit The Royal Central School of Speech and Drama will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The Royal Central School of Speech and Drama to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The Royal Central School of Speech and Drama or your bank or building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The Royal Central School of Speech and Drama asks you to.
